Notice of Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic Order

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 - Section 14

Denbighshire County Council has made an Order prohibiting vehicles using that length of road referred to in the Schedule below.

The closure is necessary to facilitate surface dressing by Denbighshire County Council Works Unit. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The signposted alternative route will be via B5429, A494, A525

The Order is effective from 9th July 2022 for an eighteen month period or the earlier completion of the works whichever is soonest. The works are expected to last approximately until 30th September 2022.

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 - Section 14

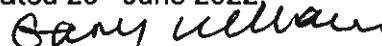
Denbighshire County Council intends not sooner than 7 days from 29th June 2022 to make an Order prohibiting vehicles using that length of Church Street, Rhuddlan, in the County of Denbigh which extends from its junction with High Street in a north westerly direction for a distance of approximately 150 metres.

The closure is necessary to facilitate roofing works. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the period of closure.

The signposted alternative route will be via Tan Y Eglwys, Gwindy Street, and High Street.

The Order is effective from 18th July 2022 for an eighteen month period or the earlier completion of the works whichever is soonest. The works are expected to last approximately until 31st July 2022.

Notice of Temporary Suspension of Parking bays

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 - Section 14

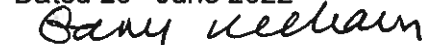
Denbighshire County Council has made an Order which will temporarily suspend the use of certain parking bays located on Vale Road Rhyl in the County of Denbigh from its junction with Westfield Road, along the south western kerb line in a south easterly direction for a distance of approximately 25 metres.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.

The reason for the suspension is to facilitate electrical works by O'Connor Utilities on behalf of Scottish Power

The Order comes into force on 4th July 2022, and will remain in force for a period of eighteen months or until the completion of the works whichever is the earlier. The works are expected to last approximately until 8th July 2022

Mae Cyngor Sir Ddinbych wedi gwneud Gorchymyn a'i effaith yw:-

- 1) Gosod terfyn cyflymder dros dro o 10 mya ar hyd y rhan honno o'r A5104 o gyffordd yr A494 i groesffyrdd Tan y Bidwal, Corwen o'i chyffordd â'r B5436 i Fedw o'r A5104 i'w chyffordd â chroesffyrdd Tan y Bidwal yng nghyffordd Blaen lâl yr A5104.

Bydd y terfyn 10 mya mewn grym pan fo gwaith hebrwng yn mynd rhagddo ar unrhyw ddiwrnod.

- 2) Gwahardd pob cerbyd rhag goddiweddyd ar y rhan honno o'r ffordd.

A5104 Tan y Bidwal crossroads near Corwen

Notice of Temporary 10 mph Speed Restriction and No Overtaking Order

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 - Section 14

Denbighshire County Council has made an Order the effect of which is to:

- 1) Impose temporarily a 10 mph speed limit along that length of the A5104 from A494 junction to Tan y Bidwal crossroads, Corwen from its junction with B5436 to Fedw from A5104 to its junction with Tan y Bidwal crossroads on A5104 Blaen lâl junction

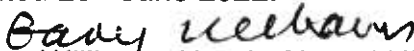
The 10 mph limit will apply when convoy work is in force on any given day.

- 2) Prohibit all vehicles from overtaking in the said length of road.

The reason for the restriction is to facilitate the safety of workmen during resurfacing works by Denbighshire County Council – Works Unit.

The Order commences on 4th July 2022 for eighteen months or the earlier completion of the works. The works are expected to last approximately until 30th September 2022.
